Your next utility bill will include these rates for all electricity used on May 1, 2009 and thereafter. It will also reflect the new electricity prices as announced by the Ontario Energy Board.

The electricity prices effective May 1, 2009, will be at 5.7 cents per kWh for electricity use up to a certain threshold per month and 6.6 cents per kWh above that threshold. For residential consumers, the monthly threshold for the lower price is set at 600 kilowatt hours from May to October.

The threshold for non-residential consumers that are eligible for the price plan will remain at 750 kilowatt hours throughout the year.
